GOING TO REACH THE WORLD

FOCUS

The 10/40 Window contains roughly two-thirds of the world's population, is home to some of the largest unreached people groups in the world, includes the majority of the world's Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists, and non-religious groups, and is largely devoid of or resistant to the Christian gospel. Indeed, it is a stronghold of "the god of this world" (2 Corinthians 4:4) ... but gospel light is breaking through and setting captives free. The focus of REACH|17 is the unreached, as well as persecuted Christians, in this 10/40 Window.

GOALS

- to learn about the nature of Christianity and missions in the persecuted 10/40 window
- to become burdened for fellow believers and the blinded masses in those regions
 - to have blinders removed from our eyes so that we see beyond the myopic view of American Christianity
 - to have cultivated within us a love for people worldwide and an appreciation for the God of the nations
- to be mobilized to live on mission and to lose our life for the sake of the gospel
 - to have opportunities to pray for and give toward 10/40 missions
- to explore ways in which we can physically involve ourselves in 10/40 missions
