## Call to Worship

As the fountain of all truth, goodness, and beauty, God deserves our trust, honor, and adoration. The call to worship invites us to consider whether we are making God the object of our worship, and stirs us to recenter our lives on him alone.

### Psalm 19:1-14

1 The heavens declare the glory of God,  
and the sky above proclaims his  
handiwork.

2 Day to day pours out speech, and  
night to night reveals knowledge.

3 There is no speech, nor are there  
words, whose voice is not heard.

4 Their voice goes out through all the  
earth, and their words to the end of the  
world. In them he has set a tent for the  
sun,

5 which comes out like a bridegroom  
leaving his chamber, and, like a strong  
man, runs its course with joy.

6 Its rising is from the end of the  
heavens, and its circuit to the end of  
them, and there is nothing hidden from  
its heat.

7 The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving  
the soul; the testimony of the Lord is  
sure, making wise the simple;

8 the precepts of the Lord are right,  
rejoicing the heart; the commandment  
of the Lord is pure, enlightening the  
eyes;

9 the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring  
forever; the rules of the Lord are true,  
and righteous altogether.

10 More to be desired are they than  
gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also  
than honey and drippings of the  
honeycomb.

11 Moreover, by them is your servant  
warned; in keeping them there is great  
reward.

12 Who can discern his errors? Declare  
me innocent from hidden faults.

13 Keep back your servant also from  
presumptuous sins; let them not have  
dominion over me!

Then I shall be blameless, and innocent  
of great transgression.

14 Let the words of my mouth and the  
meditation of my heart be acceptable in  
your sight, O Lord, my rock and my  
redeemer.

## Words of Confession - Psalm 73:21-26

21 When my soul was embittered, when afterward you will receive me to glory.  
I was pricked in heart,  
22 I was brutish and ignorant; I was like 25 Whom have I in heaven but you? And  
a beast toward you. there is nothing on earth that I desire  
besides you.  
23 Nevertheless, I am continually with 26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but  
you; you hold my right hand. God is the strength of my heart and my  
24 You guide me with your counsel, and portion forever.

## Song of Confession - "Jesus Is Mine"

Confession means we are completely honest with God and others about our flaws and failures. Instead of hiding in shame or pride, we admit our sin, and open ourselves to God's mercy available through Christ alone.
